What is the Rodeo Pilot Proposal?

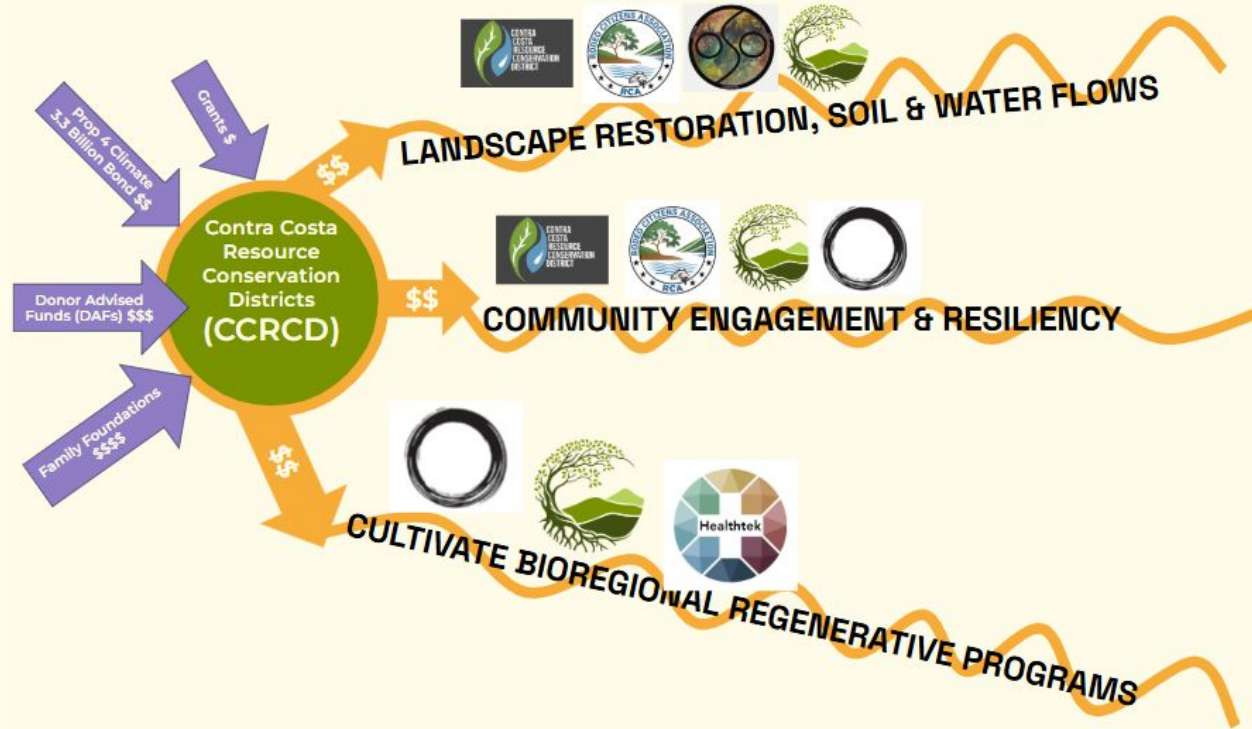
A plan to expand existing landscape conservation and community engagement programming **while also prototyping regenerative frameworks and collaborative pilot programs**, whose objective is to build resilient urban communities ready for whatever arrives in the years ahead.

Our thesis is an **activated community** can work together to re-contextualize daily life, to support local, regional and planetary ecologies. Practices leading to recontextualizing include restoration of soil health and water cycles, **working together with their neighbors, and growing healthy soil, food, community connections, and hyper local resiliency.**

- Aligning with their collective intentions and values

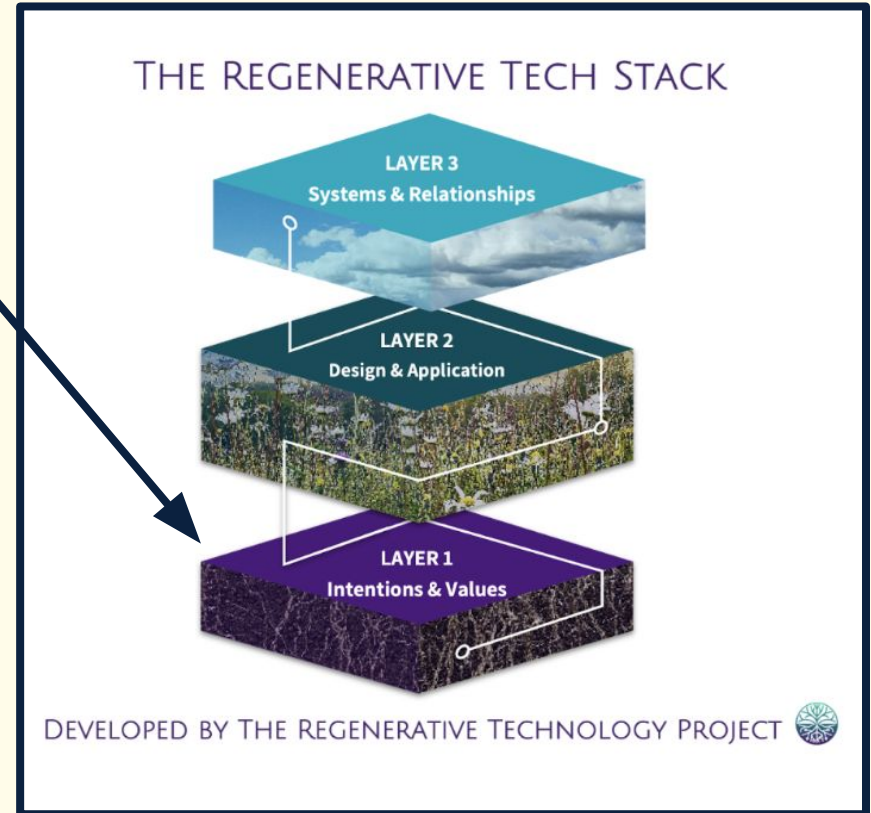
BIG VISION

A decentralized, locally operated ecosystem platform managed by local collectives (aka Neighborhoods) to coordinate common assets and distribute based on need, equity and sufficiency for all collective members.

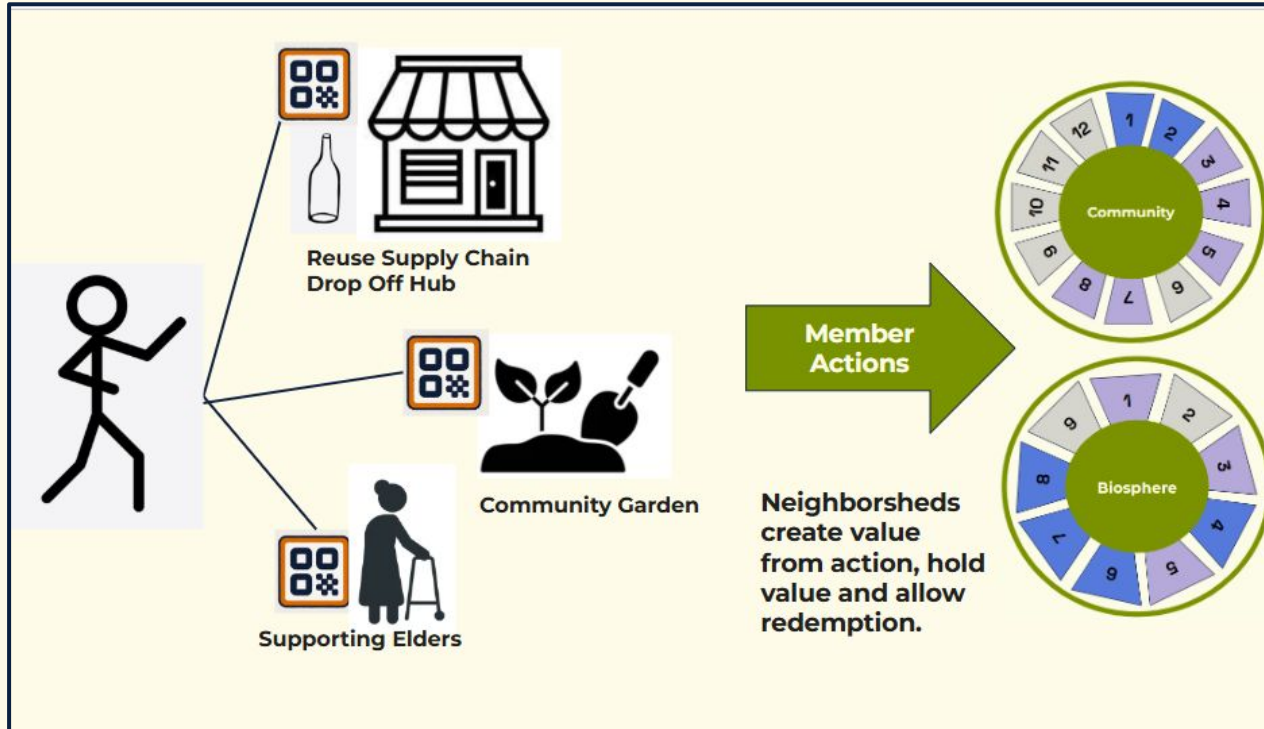

Neighborhoods Big Vision

- **A regenerative technology** that serves health and living systems, relationships of justice and reciprocity, and overall care for earth and community.
- **A regenerative economic model** based upon participating in the care and service of healing, revitalizing and ensuring circular longevity of community wellness and biosphere processes.
- **A relational rubric** designed for technological sovereignty, collective good and cultural continuity, enabling success to be measured by collective wellbeing of community and biosphere processes.

Actions mapped to the degree they are:

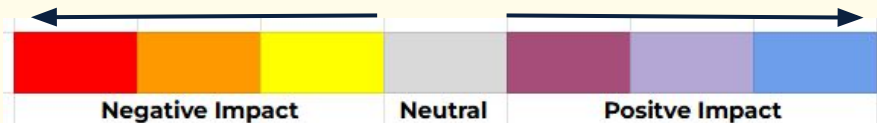
